## INSTALLATION

---

1. Remove the vehicles head unit by following the manufacturer's instructions/guidelines. Once removed, disconnect all the power connections including the 24-pin connector.

**Note: some models will not have a connection located in the 24-pin slot.**

2. Connect the red & black 8V wires if the camera being used needs an 8V power supply.

**Note: if installing a 12V camera, this will need to be powered by an alternative fused, ignition live 12V power supply from the vehicle.**

3. Connect the single grey cable labelled 'REV' to a source of reverse. A typical source would be the reversing lights circuit if there is not a specific connection behind the head unit.

4. With the aftermarket camera installed, connect this to the yellow RCA of the CAM-HD1-AD.

5. Attach the 24-pin specific connectors to the back of the head unit and to the OEM vehicle connection. When done, connect the power and test the reverse camera's functionality before reassembling the dashboard.

**Note: some models will not have a connection located in the 24-pin slot. In this case only the male end of the CAM-HD1-AD needs to be connected to the head unit, simply leave the female end loose.**
